PROGRAM COMPONENTS

TERMS 4 terms of 9 weeks each

CLASSES 2 hours/class, 3 classes/week (including chapel)

INTERNSHIP Minimum of 2.5 hours office work a week, in addition to whole day

Sundays and other midweek Favor events

READINGS & ASSESSMENTS

Recommended 2-3 hours a week per class. Expect readings and 3 to 4 assessments (per class, per term) to complete in the form of essays, reflections, devotional tasks, and small projects

^{*}This does not include church events (i.e. Presence Night, Family Night, New People Night, etc, which are required for all students.

^{**}Students are expected to do their readings and homework on their days off.

^{***}Only three absences are allowed per class each term, and three Sunday absences for the school year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Students must have at least graduated high school
- Must have intermediate English skills (reading, writing, speaking)
- Must have intermediate computer skills
- Must have access to own laptop/tablet with internet
- Must be planted in Favor Church
- Must be an active member of a Favor Connect Group
- Must have graduated Build
- Must be serving as an active volunteer at Favor Church for at least 3 months (preferred, but negotiable)
- Draft a Statement of Intent (an essay of why you would like to join Favor College - minimum of 200 words)
- Visit favor.church/college
- Fill up the application form online
- Ask your Connect Group leader for a letter of recommendation, which should be emailed directly to college@favor.church by your Connect leader
- Once all requirements have been submitted and you have met the minimum requirements, you will be scheduled for an interview.
